2. Invitation Letters for Visa Application

Due to regulatory restrictions, the invitation letter for visa applications can be issued by the hosting organization only after your registration and payment are complete. Prior to the registration, your team must be qualified for the RoboCup league.

For visa applicants, **we strongly suggest that you apply for the visa documents (e.g., the invitation letter) to the Nagoya local organizing committee (LOC) as soon as possible.** It takes a long time to process applications in some countries. Failure to obtain a visa at the appropriate time can lead to serious consequences, such as not being able to enter Japan. Such problems apparently arose in 2016. The LOC is not responsible for the results of applications.

It is recommended that you receive your visa by July 10, at the latest.

3. Travel

Arriving in Nagoya from overseas

Located about 40 kilometers from Nagoya, Central Japan International Airport (Centrair) is conveniently connected to Nagoya and various locations across central Japan by public transportation.

For access to Nagoya Station, the train is the fastest and most convenient option. The Meitetsu Airport Limited Express train connects the airport to the station in approx. 30 min.

Nagoya Station is the most convenient arrival point, as it offers easy access to the venue.

From Nagoya Station to Kinjo-Futo Station (the nearest station to the venue), you can take the Aonami Line, which takes approx. 24 min.

6. Carry-On Baggage

Please check with your airline in advance of your flight regarding what items you can bring as carry-on baggage, if you have a plan to carry your robots or batteries with you. Every airline has its own guidelines and restrictions regarding carry-on baggage.

If you are planning to bring your robots with you as carry-on baggage, you are advised to apply for an ATA Carnet before your departure in order to facilitate customs clearance.

Please contact **the ATA Carnet issuing authorities** in your country for information such as the costs, processing time or documents necessary for your application.
